Description:

Multi-speed combi bratt pan/boiler GN3/1

Free standing version with drawer at the substructure and double walled hinged lid with handle.

Material: 18/10 stainless steel DIN 1.4301 Switch, inspection cover, rear panel and upper floor in the substructure removable. Substructure 3 sides closed front with drawer.

4 adjustable feet that can be removed for installation on a pedestal. Rear 20 mm on edge and connector system with hairline joint.

The frying area is made of hard plated highgrade steel with rounded corners (R12), the useable surface from GN 2/1 has a depth of 215 mm. The surface of CNS 3 mm with the special grinding surface pattern takes care for a good non-stick effect and roasting results. The frying area is equipped with Teflon plug for the round drain tap (Ø55 mm), plus a ball valve into a GN 1/1-200 mm container which is in a drawer at the substructure. The frame is jointlessly from the top of the plate welded (hygiene!), Means that no grease inlet down possible. High-performance speed heating element with 3 heat zones. 1 'Boil' setting and 'Soft' setting to bring up the boil.

Cavity in pan enables GN containers to be hung inside and contents boiled with the lid on.

The package includes: Removable splash, grease tray, turning spatula, Teflon plug, stainless steel cleaning sponge and lead

Optional:

- Preparation for energy optimisation (electric oven only)
- 2" drain top at the front
- Drain top for cleaning
